**SUBJECT:** 2005 Self-Sufficiency Standard Update

The City of Long Beach Workforce Development Bureau is required to provide intensive and training services to employed WIA Adults and Dislocated Worker customers that are employed, when they are not earning an income above the local self-sufficiency standard.

The City of Long Beach Workforce Development Board adopted policy Memorandum #4 in 2001 to set the standard for this requirement based on a well-respected Publication produced by National Economic Development and Law Center (2003). Annually, we have updated the standard to reflect trends in the economy based on the Lower Living Income Standard (Department of Health and Human Services).

To reflect the most current data available on this topic, our internal Self-Sufficiency standard has been revised accordingly for 2005. The tables below reflect these updates.
